

Looking the Part: SLANT

There is NO difference between being a great student and looking like a great student!

Sit in the Front Students who sit in the front pay better attention to lessons. They interact more in classroom discussions and activities.

Lean Forward Lean forward in your desk. The teacher and fellow students will think you are very interested in the lesson. As you act more interested, you really will be more interested.

Ask Questions Ask meaningful questions about class activities, discussions, and lectures. One student's questions will help others better understand the information.

Nod Your Head Nod your head when the teacher looks at you during a lesson to show interest or in agreement. The teacher will interact with you more in class and think you are a positive influence.

Talk to the Teacher

Teachers really enjoy talking to students. Give a friendly “Hello” or “Goodbye” or ask questions to start a conversation.
